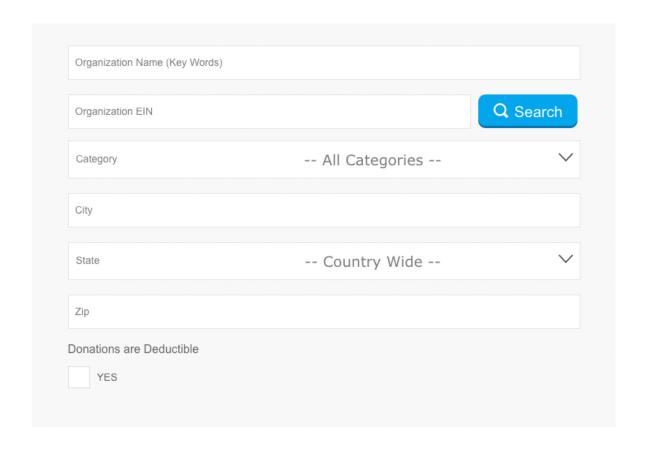
Claiming your charity on OrgHunter.com is a simple and easy process.

Step one - visit http://orghunter.com/advance_search

Enter your charities EIN number and select the search option as seen in the image below. If you are not sure of your charity's EIN number, simply enter your charity name, city, state and ZIP Code into the search fields and select the search option. You will be presented with a list of organizations that match your search criteria. Select the **Charity Details** button next to your organization's name.

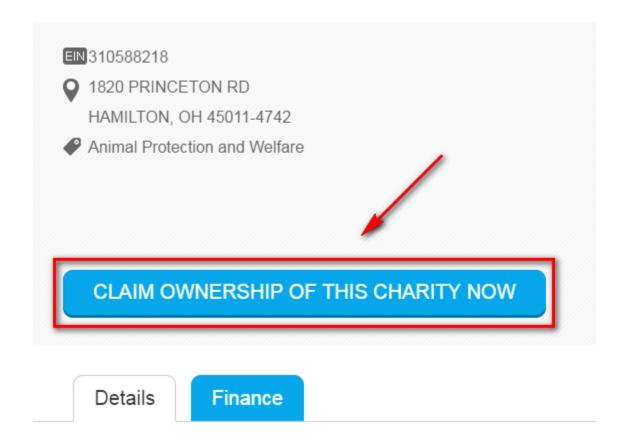
Advanced Search

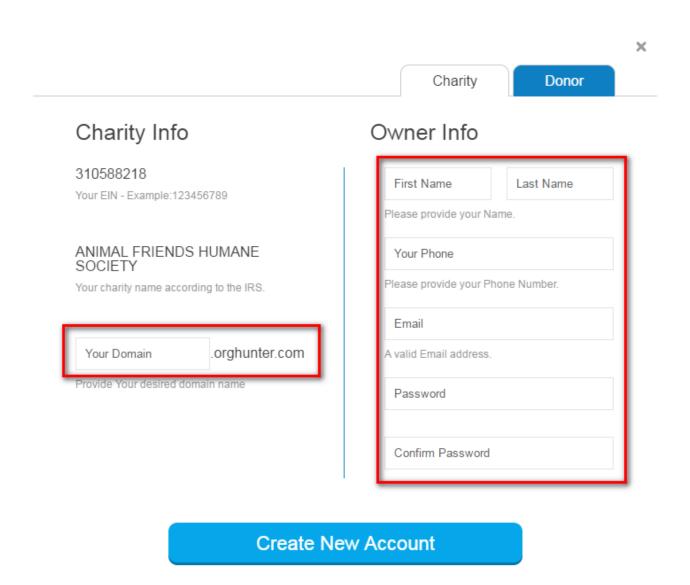
When you arrive on your charities detail page, select the **claim ownership of this charity now** button just below your address. In some cases, you may find that the information that we have on file needs to be updated. Once your organization has completed the vetting process, you will have the opportunity to update this within your Charity profile.





You will be prompted to complete a basic registration form. Notice in the image below there is the option to create a subdomain (Your Domain) for your Charity profile on OrgHunter.com. This is an important first step to establish your Charity profile on Orghunter. When your organization successfully completes the vetting process your Charity profile will be live to the world. If you select a subdomain such as mycharityname, the address of your Charity profile will become http://mycharityname.orghunter.com

From this new domain on OrgHunter you will be able to update your Charity profile along with many other attributes related to your organization.





Step two - updating your Charity profile on OrgHunter.com. The vetting process typically takes less than one day. **Important**: Complete step two only after your organization has been vetted

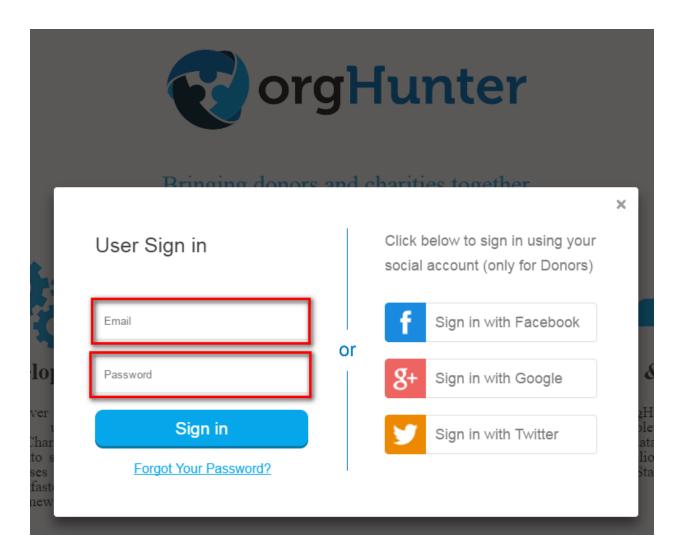
Upon successful completion of the vetting process, your organization will receive an activation email.

Visit OrgHunter.com and select the sign in button as demonstrated in the image below. Be sure to select sign out if you notice the sign in option is **not** available when you arrive to this page.



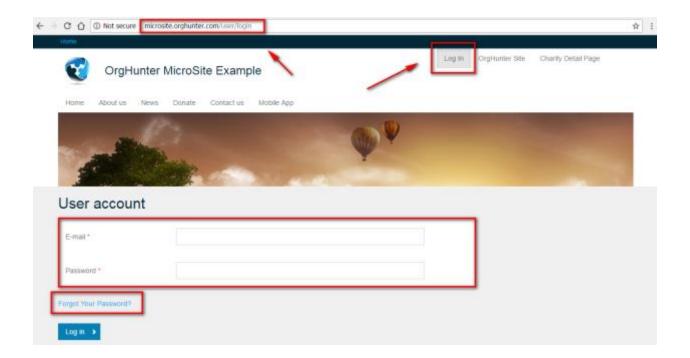


Enter the email and password used to register your account. If you are not sure of your login details simply select the forgot your password option below the sign in button.






Upon successful authentication during the sign in process you will be automatically redirected to your charity's profile. In the future, you can go directly to your charities profile page as seen in the image below. Substitute the word **microsite** in the website address with your charities subdomain name you selected during the registration process. You will notice there is a login button available for you to sign in.






Navigate to the drop-down menu on the right-hand side labeled dashboard. Here you will find a number of options available to your organization. Select the Charity Profile option to update your information OrgHunter.



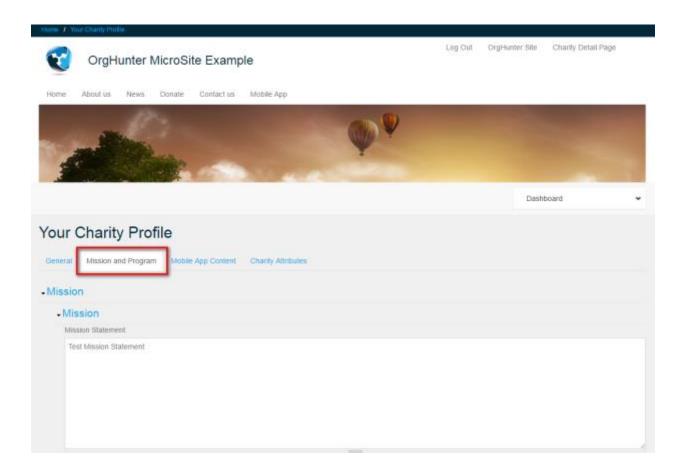


The charity profile section is comprised of four tabs. Under each tab, you can expand the section by clicking on the arrow next to the section name.



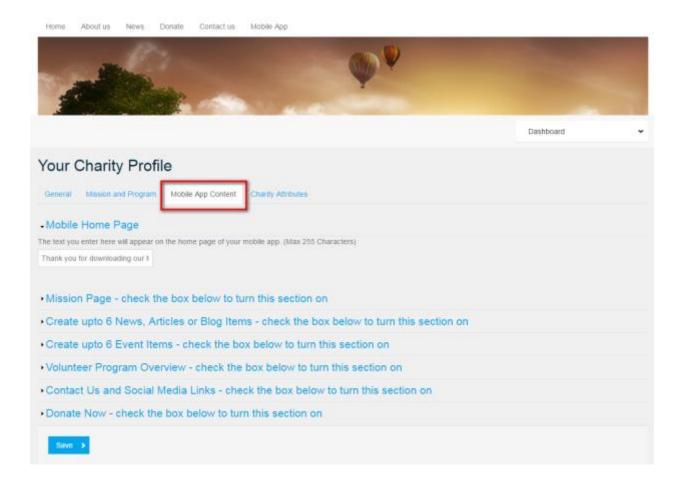

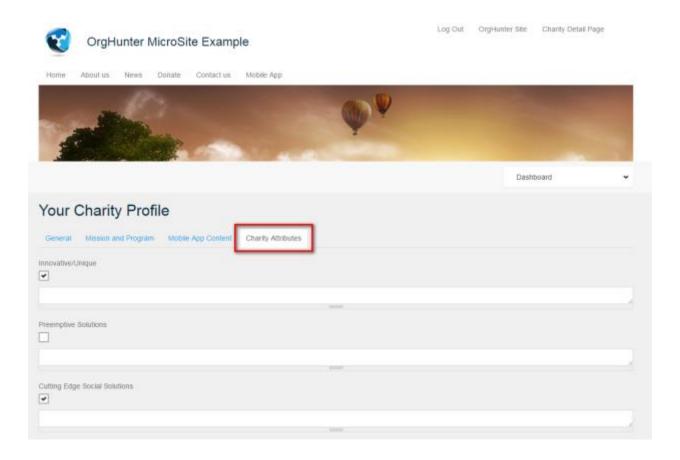


In this section, you have the option to create a mobile friendly webpage for your organization.



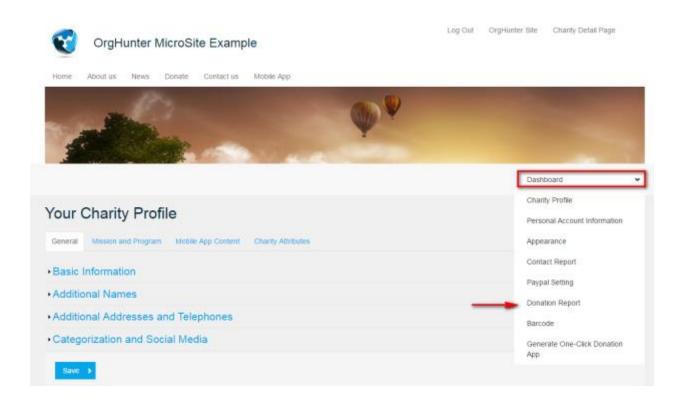

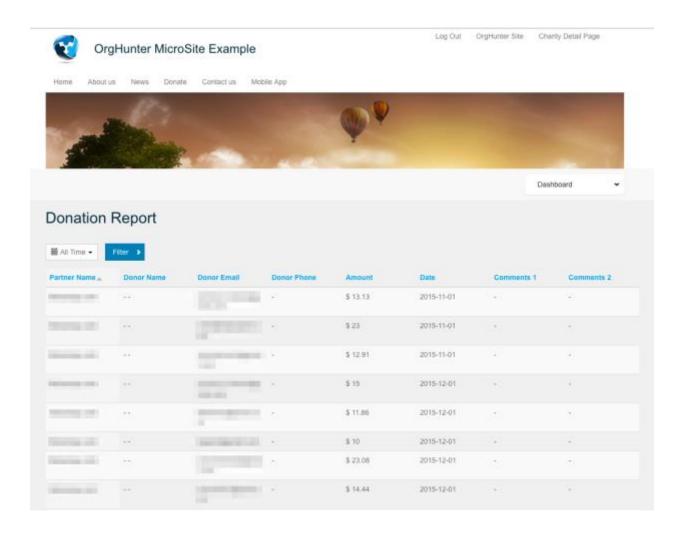

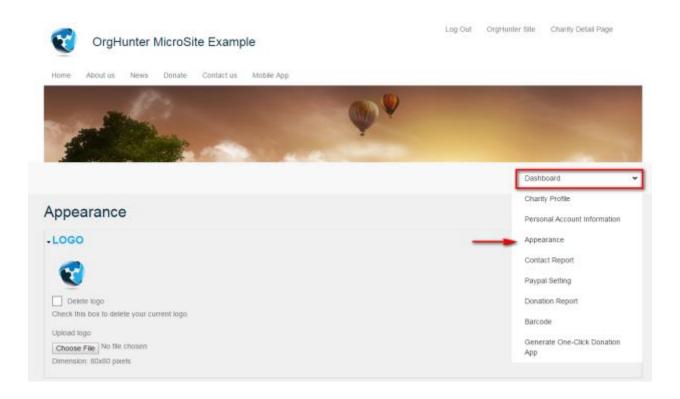


Below you will find an example of a donation report. At the bottom of the screen there is an option to download the report directly to your computer.



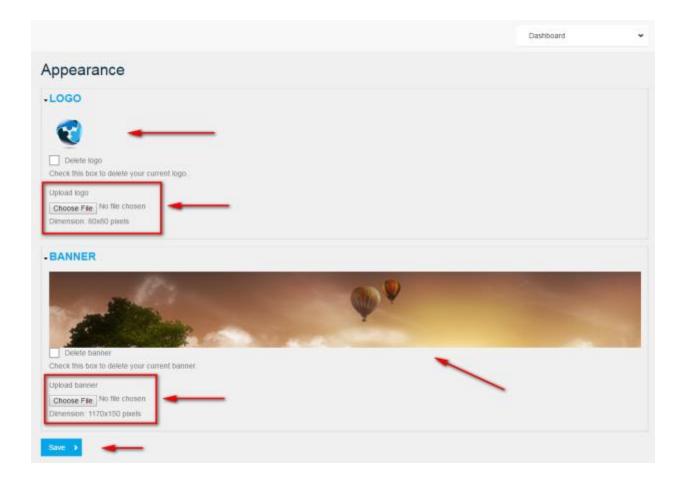


Navigate to the dashboard drop-down menu on the right side of the screen and select the Appearance option.
